

# EXECUTIVE Education Program

The Defense Security Cooperation University (DSCU) is now offering executive-level courses for executives and leaders from any U.S. Government agency with Security Cooperation (SC) responsibilities who seek to build upon and refine their SC knowledge. The focus is on a broad understanding of SC and its strategic application to achieve defense and national security objectives.

DSCU, the Department of Defense's Center of Excellence for SC education and training, offers two course options for executives - both funded by the Defense Security Cooperation Agency. Note: Each course will be hosted either virtually via live webinar or at the DSCU National Capital Region in Crystal City, VA. Note the location when you register.

- Executive level certification option is for all GO/FO/SES members of the SCW, and also for GS-15/O-6/E-9 members of the SCW in key positions.
- Executive level certification requires completion of SC-101 as a pre-requisite to registration for EXEC-901. EXEC-911 is not a certification course.

## SECURITY COOPERATION EXECUTIVE

(EXEC-901)

A five-day course, the Executive Level Certification provides baseline SC training along with executive-level review of major U.S. Government SC structures, policies, and programs. The small group format allows students to gain a deep understanding of how SC can be used as a tool for national power in support of the National Defense Strategy, and how to discuss and interpret SC issues relative to the broader problem set of national security. Lessons of interest include:

- Strategic Competition and SC
- Current issues in SC
- SC in the Defense Industrial Base
- History of SC

## SENIOR EXECUTIVE SEMINAR

(EXEC-911)

This bespoke course is for 2-Star General and Flag Officer or equivalents and above and will provide a strategic overview of SC for leaders in key government positions. This private course is taught on demand and will be tailored specifically to the leader's time, requirements, regional focus, and interest. DSCU will plan detailed course content with the executive's staff to ensure it is of the highest value. The expected length is 2-days but this can be adjusted based on needs.
