Functional Area Description

This Acquisition Functional Area includes acquisition of items and services under FMS or Title 10 authorities including co-production programs, international arms Cooperation (IAC), and International Cooperative Programs (ICPs). It focuses on acquiring defense articles and services using the DoD acquisition process for international partners. Specifically, workforce members will be able to identify their role within the broad framework of DoD SC acquisition.

How will this better prepare you for your work?

DoD SC acquisition is a system of systems that demands teamwork to develop SC acquisition programs effectively and responsively, while also utilizing the DoD acquisition framework to execute requirements.
